Use the scale below to respond to each statement:

1 = Never 2 = Seldom 3 = Occasionally 4 = Frequent 5 = Always

DISCOVER:

1. I practice a regular quiet time (prayer time) and look forward to that time with Christ.	
2. I read God’s Word (the Bible) regularly/daily.	
3. I engage regularly (at least weekly) with the gathering of the saints in worship, prayer, and study.	
4. I listen to God. I can “hear” His voice (I recognize when He is speaking to me).	
5. Peace, contentment, and joy characterize my life rather than worry and anxiety.	
6. I remain confident in God’s love, provision, and salvation during both good and difficult times.

DEVELOP:

1. I see (and others see) an increase in patience, gentleness, and self-control in my life.	
2. I am growing in Biblical knowledge and the ability to discern God’s will.	
3. I walk by the Spirit and not by my flesh (I do what God wants and not what I want).	
4. I am sinning less, and loving God and others more.	
5. I lay down my own plans when God calls me to do His work, serve others, and gather with the saints.	
6. My private life and my public life are the same.

DEPLOY:

1. I share my faith in Christ with non-believers.	
2. I understand my spiritual gifts and use those gifts to serve others inside and outside the church.	
3. I invite others to join me at church gatherings, Bible studies, and/or small group gatherings.	
4. I expect God to use me every day for His kingdom mission and work (and see evidence of this).	
5. I intentionally engage in my community for the purpose of bringing God’s truth and His kingdom.	
6. My actions demonstrate a commitment to the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)

Note: Each section (Discover, Develop, Deploy) has a maximum score of **30**. No one will score a 30 in any of the three sections; however, **a score at or below 20 should indicate a need to act**, and to seek guidance and accountability.

- For guidance, contact an Evident Life Church pastor. Let’s sit down and prayerfully seek the Lord for His plan.
- We are better together, and we get better together. This is how God made us. This is part of His sovereign formula for Christian living. - Spend time daily with God in His Word (the Bible, not just listening to a sermon online or reading a Christian book), and spend time daily in prayer, waiting on the Lord, listening to Him and for Him.
- Regularly share the Gospel of Jesus with others and invite others to join you at church: worship and small group.
